Dear Sir,

It is to inform you that the Government of India has launched a Scheme named "RAJIV GANDHI ADVOCATES TRAINING SCHEME." Under this scheme, only 10 young practicing Advocates from each State will be imparted professional training every year. The Bar Council of India shall be the Nodal Agency for monitoring the implementation of the Scheme. The training programme will commence from 15th September, 2014 to 14th October, 2014. The National Law University, Jodhpur will provide training to the selected young advocates.

The object of the Scheme is to motivate and encourage young talented lawyers to remain in practice at the Bar at grass roots level, and for that purpose to impart them professional training.

It is further informed that the selected candidates shall be provided professional training of two months. Training would be of two components i.e., (i) Training to be imparted in a National Law School/University Law School - one month; and (ii) Training under a Senior/leading Advocate – one month. Necessary facilities like study material, free lodging and boarding shall be provided to the selected candidates during the training programme.

The Advocates practicing in a Magistrate and Munsif Court, who are not above the age of 30 years and having monthly income not more than Rs.15,000/- p.m. shall be eligible under this Scheme. Preference will be given to SC/ST/Women/OBC/Physical Handicapped Advocates.

On receipt of application forms from the eligible candidates, the Selection Committee will select the suitable candidates and forward the names of selected candidates to the Bar Council of India.

You are therefore requested to kindly give wide publicity amongst the Members of your Bar and place the letter on the notice board of your Bar Association, so that maximum Advocates may take benefit of this scheme. The application forms duly filled in from the concerned Advocate/(s), who are willing to participate in the Training Programme, should reach in the office of the Bar Council of Rajasthan, Jodhpur **on or before 22/5/2014** positively in the enclosed performa.

An early response is requested.
